- 350+ classic, iconic cars - the best of which form a parade through the village that kick starts the day.
- Over a dozen steam traction engines.
- Historic working canal boats.
- Vintage bicycles, scooters and motorbikes.
- Model railways.
- Military vehicles.
- A huge Lego hall.
- Attractions such as remote controlled racing cars, circus bikes and giant sandpits.
- 25+ Independent stalls selling everything from vintage clothes and toy cars to artisan walking sticks.
- 20+ Vendors, selling an eclectic mix of delicious sweet and savoury food, plus a whole range of drinks.
- Live music from several bands through the day.
