

DONATIONS AND PAYMENT TO VOLUNTEER SUPPORT GROUPS FOR 2019

On April 20th 2020 Lymm Historic Transport Group donated £1,000 to local Samaritans groups in Warrington and Northwich. Samaritans is a volunteer run charity that provides a vital service that more than ever is needed during these difficult times. Its fundraising activities have been severely curtailed by the current situation

Earlier in the Coronavirus crisis we also donated £3,000 to Warrington Foodbank as well as £3,000 to St Roccas.

After last year's event and long before the crisis we were also able to donate £3,000 to Lymm Heritage Centre. That has now become a vital lifeline to this local charity. Another £1,000 went to Maggie's Cancer Centres and £500 to the RAF Benevolent Fund who provided our fantastic flypast last year. In addition to that we handed over £1,600 to local Scout and ATC groups who had helped out on the day.

That's £13,100 in total! all only possible thanks to all the exhibitors, cars, boats, bikes, railways, traction engines and everything else who make the event what it is, plus the visitors who hand over their entry money.... and of course not forgetting the group of volunteers who make it all happen in the first place.
