- 400+ classic, iconic cars the best of which form a parade through the village that kick starts the day.
- Over a dozen steam traction engines.
- · Historic working canal boats.
- Vintage bicycles, scooters and motorbikes.
- Model railways
- Military vehicles and F1 cars
- A huge Lego hall.
- Attractions such as remote controlled racing cars, circus bikes, giant sandpits and a petting farm.
- 25+ Independent stalls selling everything from vintage clothes and toy cars to artisan walking sticks.
- 20+ Vendors, selling an eclectic mix of delicious sweet and savoury food, plus a whole range of drinks.
- Live music from several bands through the day.

### WHAT WE'RE ABOUT...



Two aspects make Lymm Historic Transport Day unique. Firstly, ours is a *community* event, entirely run by volunteers with all our profits donated to charities. From the flyering to the manning of the gates, everyone involved gives their time freely because the event has such a positive impact on the village.

Secondly, this event is more than just a car show, it celebrates all things historical transport - from bikes and bicycles, to planes, trains and boats. It brings together lots of different enthusiasts, making the day truly special and very popular.



### **SPONSORSHIP**



It's thanks to the generosity of local companies that Historic Transport Day is able to return each year. As a non-profit event, it's only the funds we receive from their sponsorship that keeps us going! Each year we work with 4-5 sponsors, who each donate  $\pounds500 - \pounds1500$ pounds. In return they get:
